YELLOW TEA

Yellow tea is a rare style similar to green, but with an additional processing step called 'menhuang' where the freshly fired leaves are wrapped in small bundles and delicately slow-roasted before drying. This reduces grassiness and increases florals.

Ingredients: Organic figs, organic cherries, apricots, mango, pitted dates, raw almonds.

A light savory snack traditionally eaten as a quick meal with tea, simmered in a broth of rotating loose-leaf teas and spices.

Ingredients: Loose-leaf tea, cassia bark, Sichuan peppercorn, star anise, ginger root, fennel seeds, bay leaf, salt.

Whole-grain scone featuring organic rye flour and butternut squash puree complemented with aged cheddar and jalapeños.

Ingredients: Organic all-purpose flour, organic rye flour, sugar, organic cream, buttermilk, aged white cheddar, butter, organic jalapeños, organic butternut squash, baking powder, salt.

Strawberry Black Sesame Cookies | Rosebud Bakery

These soft and chewy cookies are sweet and savory with strawberry, vanilla, black sesame seeds, and Chinese five-spice.

Ingredients: Butter, sugar, egg, organic all-purpose flour, freeze-dried strawberries, baking powder, baking soda, salt, vanilla, Chinese five-spice powder, toasted black sesame seeds.

Coconut Cardamom Shortbread Cookies | Rosebud Bakery These cookies are sweet, salty, crispy, and chewy. The toasted coconut is complemented nicely with the floral, citrusy fresh ground cardamom.
